

Vassar Dance Project (VDP) is the first New York City presentation of choreography from Vassar College students, faculty, and alumni May 11th and 12th, 2002 at University Settlement (184 Eldridge Street at Rivington). VDP at University Settlement will showcase the choreography of Kim Dooley, Tom Price, Liz Claire and Leo Beletsky along side current Vassar Repertory Dance Theatre talent performing re-stagings of Louis Falco's *Escargot* and an excerpt from *Heptasoph* by Jeff Duncan.

Since 2000, VDP has pursued its mission as a creative forum for the Dance and Dance Theater community of Vassar alumni, students and faculty. In the 2000-2001 season, the Project presented two evening-length showcases of alumni works at Vassar College. It is the success of these presentations that created the inertia for the University Settlement showcase, which marks a historic debut of Vassar dance in New York City.

This May's showcase is an hour-long presentation of works in Dance and Dance Theater, ranging from historic re-stagings of Post-Modernists Jeff Duncan and Louis Falco to brand new pieces created especially for this event.
